New ALICE Report Launched

ALICE is an acronym (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed), created by the United Way to describe the many members of our community who work hard and make enough money to stay out of poverty, but not quite enough to make ends meet.

According to the newly updated ALICE report, more than 43% of Floridians now live in this precarious financial situation. On February 22nd, President Philip Brown and Board Member Bob Thompson joined United Way of Florida President, Ted Granger to launch the new report and advocate for the ALICE population to the legislature in Tallahassee.


