## **FLKRS Analysis**

The Impact of Covid on school has been seen throughout the state. The rate of test takers showing 'kindergarten readiness' in the state of Florida is 57%, and only 55% in Sarasota County. Sarasota also saw a 21% decrease in students entering kindergarten.

## **FSA Analysis**

Across the state, including our 5 counties, all age groups have declined in showing proficiency in English Language Arts despite already starting at a low average of 54-57%. In 2021, the achievement for Sarasota County for grades 3-5 is 65%

## **Unemployment**

While the standard unemployment rate for each county we serve is between 4.2 and 4.5%, that number doubles when you factor in individuals no longer looking but employable, as well as those who are underemployed seeking an alternative with true living wages.
